

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MAY 10, 2008 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 08140-02, SURVEY F16001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-12 FOR THE SURVEY OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 16-20-12 FOR JOE BIGGS, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE SOUTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12 TO BE ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 16-20-12, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

**HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,320.78' WEST TO THE 3/4" IRON PIN FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
- 2) 1,323.59' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
- 3) 2,647.17' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
- 4) 1,320.77' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
- 5) 3,969.61' EAST TO THE 5/8" REBAR ATTRIBUTABLE TO L. M. GOULD HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 16-20-12
