- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 152, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 152 DATED NOVEMBER 22 & 23, 1886 ORDERED BY H. F. LAMB TO LOCATE THE LINES AND CORNERS TO THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-20-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5" X 8" X 14" LIMESTONE MARKED "C"** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,317.5' WEST TO THE 4" X 9" X 13" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 20-20-12
 - 2) 2,635' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12
