

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 152, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 152 DATED NOVEMBER 22 & 23, 1886 ORDERED BY H. F. LAMB TO LOCATE THE LINES AND CORNERS TO THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-20-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 4" X 9" X 13" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-20-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

- 1) 1,317.5' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12
- 2) 1,317.5' EAST TO THE 5" X 8" X 14" LIMESTONE MARKED "C" HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12
