EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 70, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 70 DATED OCTOBER 13-14, 1884 ORDERED BY V. G. BAYSINGER, R. W. BAYSINGER, D. N. TWEEDY, J. J. TWEEDY, AND R. A. MARSHALL TO LOCATE THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 23-20-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** AT THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-20-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 1) 1,317' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12
- 2) 1,317' EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12
- 3) 3,951' EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12
