EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 70, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 70 DATED OCTOBER 13-14, 1884 ORDERED BY V. G. BAYSINGER, R. W. BAYSINGER, D. N. TWEEDY, J. J. TWEEDY, AND R. A. MARSHALL TO LOCATE THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 23-20-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-20-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,318' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12
- 2) 1,318' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12
