

NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 546 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 8" X 6"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 13, 14, 23 & 24-20-12 ON JULY 4, 1857.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.03 CHAINS EAST TO THE 19" X 10" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 13 & 24-20-12
 - 2) 80.05 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 15" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 13 & 24-20-12 ON THE EAST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY

- 2) IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGE 126 [PACKET 238 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] ON A PETITION BY MATT P. BAYSINGER AND OTHERS FOR SECTION LINE ROADS ON TOWNSHIP 20-12 WITHOUT A SURVEY, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ORDERED THE SECTION LINES FOR THE SECOND ROAD DECLARED PUBLIC HIGHWAYS ESTABLISHED ON JUNE 12, 1869. A NOTE IN THE LEFT MARGIN STATES: THE LAW OF 1869 PROVIDES 40 FEET WIDTH ON SECTION LINE ROADS. SEE COMMISSION RECORD PAGE 229.
THE NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS SECOND ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINE TO THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 14-20-12 TO THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD
 - 2) THE SECOND ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 35-20-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD

- 3) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 43 DATED FEBRUARY 13, 1883 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20, RANGES 12 & 13 FOR R. W. BAYSINGER, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT "BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16, T. 20, R. 13, I RAN WEST ON THE SECTION LINE TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 16, T. 20, R. 12, A DISTANCE OF SEVEN MILES AS SHOWN BY STONES OF THE U. S. SURVEY", INDICATING THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 13-20-12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD.

- 4) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 210 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 426 TO 428 PETITION BY R. W. BAYSINGER AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 20-12 AND 2-13 [PACKET 473 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON FEBRUARY 13, 1883, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT AND 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD AS DESCRIBED IN THE FIELD NOTES OF THE COUNTY SURVEYOR, ON APRIL 13, 1883 AS NOTED BY J. E. JONES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND WAS RECORDED ON MAY 7, 1883 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER SECTION 13-20-12 ON THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS 50 FOOT WIDE FIRST ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 3 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 16-20-12 AT THE TERMINUS OF THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS 50 FOOT WIDE FIRST ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 4 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-20-13 TO COMMENCE OF THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 5) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, BY MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 70, A **PERMANENT SURVEY**

RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 70 DATED OCTOBER 13-14, 1884 ORDERED BY V. G. BAYSINGER, R. W. BAYSINGER, D. N. TWEEDY, J. J. TWEEDY, AND R. A. MARSHALL TO LOCATE THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND SUBDIVIDE SECTION 23-20-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 2,634' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12
- 2) 3,951' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 23-20-12
- 3) 5,268' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12
- 4) 1,318' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 23-20-12
- 5) 2,636' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12
- 6) 5,272' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 23-20-12

ON JANUARY 2, 1951 A PETITION SIGNED BY E. W. MULKEY FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-12 WAS PRESENTED TO GEORGE K. JACKSON, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND R. W. BALL, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON JANUARY 23, 1951 AND THE FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON JANUARY 23, 1951 **VACATED** THE FOLLOWING ROAD:

- 1) BEGINNING ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 13-20-12, THENCE SOUTH ONE MILE TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECTION AND THERE ENDING.
