WELCH TO SURVEY THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-20-12, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED THE **THEORETICAL LOCATION** FOR THE EAST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-20-12 TO BE ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-20-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
