MACLEMAN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 205 DATED MAY 1, 1878 ORDERED BY THOMAS E. WELCH TO SURVEY THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-20-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 26-20-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-20-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 26-20-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS SURVEY NOTES/ DRAWING SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 79 RODS, 16-1/2 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26-20-12
  - 2) 79 RODS, 16-1/2 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 26-20-12
  - 3) 79 RODS, 22-1/2 LINKS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 26-20-12
