- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 152, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 152 DATED NOVEMBER 22 & 23, 1886 ORDERED BY H. F. LAMB TO LOCATE THE LINES AND CORNERS TO THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-20-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5" X 7" X 14" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-20-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER AND THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,317' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12
- 2) 3,942' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-20-12
- 3) 1,317' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AND **HE SET DEEPER IN THE GROUND** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12
- 4) 3,948' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12
