

**NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 562 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 19, 20, 29 & 30-20-12.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 40.02 CHAINS EAST TO THE 24" X 12" X 2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 20 & 29-20-12
  - 2) 80.03 CHAINS EAST TO THE 24" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 20, 21, 28 & 29-20-12
  
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 271 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 34 TO 36 PETITIONED BY HUGH ROBERTS AND OTHERS FOR THREE ROADS IN TOWNSHIP 20-12 [PACKET 515 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON JUNE 15, 1884, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE NORTH-SOUTH AND 50 FOOT WIDE EAST-WEST ROADS ON JULY 15, 1884, AS NOTED BY P. Y. HALLBERG, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON NOVEMBER 20, 1884 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30-20-12 ON ALL THREE ROADS ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) THIS FIRST ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 2 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18-20-12 AT THE TERMINUS OF THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
  - 2) THIS FIRST ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES TO AN ANGLE STONE HE SET IN THE NE/4 OF SECTION 32-20-12; THEN GOES THROUGH 3 ANGLE STONES TO A POINT 188 FEET EAST OF THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-12; THEN WEST 188 FEET TO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-12 TO BEGIN THE FIRST ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
  - 3) THE SECOND ROAD BEGINS AT THIS CORNER AND EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 1/2 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29-20-12 AT THE TERMINUS OF THE SECOND ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
  - 4) THE THIRD ROAD BEGINS AT THIS CORNER AND EXTENDS WEST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 1 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 30-20-12 ON THE RANGE LINE AT THE TERMINUS OF THE THIRD ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
  
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 152, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 152 DATED NOVEMBER 22 & 23, 1886 ORDERED BY H. F. LAMB TO LOCATE THE LINES AND CORNERS TO THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 20-20-12, SAID THAT HE FOUND "UNMISTAKABLE EVIDENCE OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER HAVING BEEN WHERE IT LAY" AT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12. **HE SET THE STONE DEEPER IN THE GROUND ON THIS PERMANENT SURVEY.**  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 2,625' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-20-12
  - 2) 1,317' EAST TO THE 5" X 7" X 14" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 20-20-12
  - 3) 2,634' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AND **HE SET DEEPER IN THE GROUND** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12
  - 4) 5,265' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 20-20-12

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED DECEMBER 13, 2010 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 10347-02, A SURVEY WHERE NO DRAWING WAS REQUIRED, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A 1/2" REBAR OF UNKNOWN ORIGIN** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29-20-12 FROM EXISTING REFERENCE TIES ON FILE IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE BY HIM IN 2000. **[NOTE: HIS 2000 TIES ARE MISSING FROM THE SURVEY TIE FILES – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]**
- 1) 1.3' WEST TO A LINE OF FENCE TO THE SOUTH
  - 2) 2.5' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF ROAD 90 EAST-WEST
  - 3) IN THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF ROAD "P" TO THE NORTH
  - 4) 42.15' ESE TO A 40 D NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN THE TOP OF A GATE POST
  - 5) 30.8' NW TO THE TOP CENTER OF THE WEST END OF A 30" CMP
  - 6) 25.85' SOUTH TO T 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST
