- 1) J. HARRISON PARKMAN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1907 TO 1915, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 638 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGES 421 THROUGH 424 PETITIONED BY W. L. McCLELLAND AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19-12 [PACKET 905 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON MARCH 26, 1908 AND WAS GRANTED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD, 20 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE SURVEYED LINE, ON APRIL 10, 1908 AS NOTED BY J. A. CLEMMER, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, APPARENTLY **SET A STONE** FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29-20-12 TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE 1/8TH SECTION LINE FOR 1/2 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 29-20-12 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
