

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 27, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 27 DATED MAY 3, 1884 AT THE REQUEST OF FRED LYMAN TO SURVEY THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 30-20-12, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 30-20-12 TO BE ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-20-12, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320.5' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 30-20-12
- 2) 2,641.0' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-20-12
- 3) 2,641.0' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-20-12
