GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN SURVEY F27001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-12 SHOWING THE LOCATION OF THE EAST LINE OF THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 27-20-12, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING AN "IRON PIN" AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-20-12. THE SURVEY IS NOT DATED AND THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE TILES. **VERITY BEFORE USING!! HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION: :
 - 1) 1,324.5' WEST TO THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-20-12 – NOT IDENTIFIED
 - 2) 1,324.5' EAST TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27-20-12 – NOT IDENTIFIED

- 2) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 166
ON FEBRUARY 26, 1974 A PETITION SIGNED BY KENNETH B. DILL AND OTHERS FOR THE OPENING OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-12 WAS PRESENTED TO ROSEMARY SPALDING, COUNTY CLERK. THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS VIEWED THE ROAD ON MARCH 25, 1974 AND RECOMMENDED THAT THE FOLLOWING ROAD BE OPENED, BUT THEY DID **NOT** RECORD A WIDTH:
 - 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-20-12, THENCE WEST A QUARTER OF A MILE AND THENCE ENDING.
