

SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 68 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 216 DATED OCTOBER 3, 1872 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-20-12 AND SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32 INTO QUARTERS, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 36-20-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-20-12 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-20-12 AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 336' WEST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 1-21-12 AND 6-21-13
- 2) 1,322' WEST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-20-12
- 3) 1,322' EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 36-20-12 AT THE TOWNSHIP CORNER
