1) J. H. PARKMAN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1907 TO 1915, IN SURVEY NUMBER 189, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 9 REQUESTED BY R. A. McILVAIN TO MAKE S SURVEY OF 5 ACRES ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-20-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 5 ACRE TRACT IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-20-12 AT 1,320 FEET SOUTH OF THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-20-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THE SURVEY WAS BEGUN ON APRIL 5, 1907.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-20-12
- 2) 165' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST TRACT CORNER
