- 1) SAMUEL P. DAVIES, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 51 AND DATED JUNE 1870, SAID THAT **HE SET A LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-20-12 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-13 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 19.96-3/4 CHAINS EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-12
- 2) 19.96-3/4 CHAINS WEST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-13
- 3) 59.90-1/4 CHAINS WEST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-13
- 4) 79.88 CHAINS SOUTH TO STONE HE FOUND ALREADY ESTABLISHED AT THE SOUTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 4-20-13
