

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 677 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT THE POSITION FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 4 & 5-20-13 IS AT 40.30 CHAINS SOUTH OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER, WHICH FALLS IN THE NEOSHO RIVER. **THEY SET A POST WITNESS CORNER AT 41.07 CHAINS SOUTH OF THE NORTHWEST CORNER** ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NEOSHO RIVER ON JANUARY 14, 1856, FROM WHICH:
 - 1) A WILLOW TREE 10" IN DIAMETER BEARS S. 57° E. AT 104 LINKS DISTANCE
 - 2) A WILLOW TREE 9" IN DIAMETER BEARS N. 32° W. AT 200 LINKS DISTANCE

- 2) SAMUEL P. DAVIES, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 51, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 50 DATED JUNE 8, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 9, THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 9, AND THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 20 OF RANGE 13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCE:
 - 1) 120.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 9-20-13

- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 173, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 173 DATED JUNE 20-24, 1887 ORDERED BY T. GASCHE TO SURVEY THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 4) JOHN R. YOUNG, L.S. 112, OF SCHWAB-EATON, P.A., IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT FOR THE PARTIAL BOUNDARY SURVEYS FOR THE JOHN REDMOND DAM AND RESERVOIR UNDER CONTRACT NUMBER DACW56-75-C-0129 RECORDED IN FIELD BOOK NUMBER 5-1911 DATED APRIL 1976 AND FILED IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JUNE 29, 1976 IN VOLUME 347 ON PAGE 253-A, SURVEY F05001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-13, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13 AS THE TRUE POSITION FELL IN THE NEOSHO RIVER. THIS SURVEY IS FILED IN VOLUME 347 ON PAGE 253-A IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE. HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 3,634.21' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL LOCATION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13
 - 2) 5,268.42' WEST TO THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS MONUMENT HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13
 - 3) 2,656.67' NORTH TO THE 3/4" PIPE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
 - 4) 2,636.89' SOUTH TO THE 1" IRON BAR HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13
