

CENTER CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 173, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 173 DATED JUNE 20-24, 1887 ORDERED BY T. GASCHE TO SURVEY THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A 3" X 12" X 7" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE TEMPORARY STAKE THAT HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,317' EAST TO THE 5" X 12" X 21" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4/4 CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13
- 2) 1,317' WEST TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13

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
