

WEST 1/16 CORNER SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 176, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 176 DATED MAY 24 & 25, 1887 FOR BY J. W. OSBORNE, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-13, **APPARENTLY FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-10-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13 WITH EXCEPTION FOR THE GROWING HEDGE
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13 AT A TURN ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 173, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 173 DATED JUNE 20-24, 1887 ORDERED BY T. GASCHÉ TO SURVEY THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A 5" X 12" X 21" LIMESTONE** FOR THE EAST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13 ON LINE AND MIDWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,325-1/2' NORTH TO THE 4" X 9" X 15" LIMESTONE MARKED "C" HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13
- 2) 1,325-1/2' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5-20-13
- 3) 1,317' WEST TO THE 3" X 12" X 17" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13
- 4) 2,634' WEST TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 5-20-13
