

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER NORTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 09, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) SAMUEL P. DAVIES, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 51, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 50 DATED JUNE 8, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNER OF SECTIONS 9, 8, 5 & 4, THE CENTER OF SECTION 9, AND THE CENTER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 20 OF RANGE 13, SAID THAT **HE SET A LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-20-13 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-20-13 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 1) 19.86-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9-20-13
  - 2) 19.86-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-20-13
  - 3) 59.59-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET BY MUTUAL CONSENT FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 9-20-13
  - 4) 99.19-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8-20-13
  - 5) 139.19-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 8-20-13
- 2) SAMUEL P. DAVIES, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 52, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 51 DATED JUNE 13, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 SECTION CORNER STONE ON THE NORTH LINE OF SECTION 4-20-13 AND TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 4 AND DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4 BY A LINE RUNNING EAST & WEST, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 1/2/4 STONE** "ALREADY ESTABLISHED" ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

R. WRIGHT, ET. AL. FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20, RANGE 13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-20-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

- 1) 230 FEET EAST TO AN ANGLE STONE HE SET NEAR THE NEOSHO RIVER
- 4) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 192 TO 193 [PACKET 17 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] PETITIONED BY L. W. WRIGHT AND OTHERS IN TOWNSHIP 20-13 THAT WAS SURVEYED ON JULY 26, 1871, AND WAS ORDERED OPENED, RECORDED AND ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JANUARY 1, 1872 AS ATTESTED BY DAVID S. GILMORE, COUNTY CLERK. **HE FOUND THE** NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-20-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

- 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 230 FEET TO AN ANGLE POST NEAR THE BANK OF THE NEOSHO RIVER TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY
