

WEST 1/16 CORNER NORTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, BY C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 121 DATED MARCH 21, 1882 AT THE REQUEST OF D. C. OVERLY TO ESTABLISH ON TOWNSHIP 20, RANGE 13, THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 17, THE 1/4 CORNERS ON THE NORTH AND WEST LINES AND THE CENTER CORNER AND EACH OTHER LINES AND CORNERS AS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE EST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-20-13 ON LINE AND AT THE "PROPER CORRECTION" BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 17-20-13 AND THE TRUE POSITION FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE DOES NOT DESCRIBE THE STONE AND THERE ARE NO FINAL DISTANCES ON HIS DRAWING OR IN HIS NOTES.
