

**NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 682 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 9" X 3-1/2"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 7 & 18-20-13.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 39.78 CHAINS WEST TO THE 19" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7 & 18-20-13 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
  - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 20" X 12" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 7, 8, 17 & 18-20-13
  
- 2) WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JUNE 19, 2001, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 01-59, SETTING COUNTY MONUMENT BOXES OVER SECTION CORNERS ON COUNTY ASPHALT ROADS, HAD DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, MARK THE LOCATION OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-20-13. DEPUTY BROSEMER DEEMED THAT THIS CORNER WAS **LOST** IN NORTH-SOUTH POSITION AND HE RESET IT ON LINE BETWEEN THE NORTHWEST CORNER AND THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18-20-13. HE DEEMED THAT THIS CORNER WAS **OBLITERATED** IN EAST-WEST POSITION, AND HE RESET IT ON LINE WITH THE HEDGE ROW AND TREE ROW TO THE NORTH EXTENDED. **I THEN SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP, AND SET A LYON COUNTY MONUMENT BOX FLUSH WITH THE SURFACE OF ASPHALT COUNTY ROAD 110** FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18-20-13.
  - 1) 51.5' NNE TO A PK NAIL & WASHER IN THE WEST FACE OF A POWER POLE
  - 2) 73.4' NW TO A PK NAIL & WASHER IN THE TOP OF THE WEST GATE POST
  - 3) 51.3' SOUTH TO A PK NAIL & WASHER IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST
  - 4) 57.9' SE TO A PK NAIL & WASHER IN THE TOP OF A GATE POST
  - 5) 63.6' SE TO A PK NAIL & WASHER IN THE TOP OF A BRACE POST
  - 6) IN LINE WITH A HEDGE TO THE NORTH
