SHEPHERD, TRUSTEE OF ELMENDARO TOWNSHIP, TO RESURVEY THE NORTH AND SOUTH ROAD THROUGH THE CENTER OF SECTION 28-20-13 AS THE GOVERNMENT CORNER STONES OF SAID SECTION WERE REMOVED OR DESTROYED [PACKET 613 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON AUGUST 30, 1888, WAS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON JANUARY 8, 1889 AS NOTED BY J. S. GRIMSLEY, CHAIRMAN, AND RECORDED ON JULY 30, 1889, SAID THAT **HE SET A 24" X 14" X 3" ROAD STONE MARKED "R" NEAR** THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28-20-13 ON LINE WITH THE ROAD STONES THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28-20-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
