

**NORTH 1/16 CORNER SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 18, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 18 DATED MARCH 1-5, 1870 FOR A SURVEY IN SECTION 31-20-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 31-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. **[NOTE: THERE MAY BE AN ERROR IN HIS NOTES AS THEY INDICATE THAT THIS CORNER IS NOT HALFWAY BETWEEN THE CENTER CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-13 – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR]**
- HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**
- 1) 1,290' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-13
  - 2) 1,360' WEST TO THE LARGE ROCK HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-17013
  - 3) 2,690' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 31
  - 4) 4,020' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-13 ON THE RANGE LINE
