

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 678 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 31 & 32-20-13.

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 18, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 18 DATED MARCH 1-5, 1870 FOR A SURVEY IN SECTION 31-20-13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,290' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 31-20-13
 - 2) 2,650' WEST TO THE LARGE ROCK HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-13
 - 3) 3,980' WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTH 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 31-20-13
 - 4) 5,310' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-13 ON THE RANGE LINE

- 3) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 19, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 19 DATED MARCH 1-5, 1870 TO SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

- 4) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 149 TO 150 [PACKET 317 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] ON THE PETITION OF J. M. McKEE AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 21-13 AND TOWNSHIPS 20-12 & 20-13 THAT HE SURVEYED ON APRIL 19, 1870 THAT WAS RECORDED AND ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON MAY 21, 1870 AS NOTED BY DAVID S. GILMORE, COUNTY CLERK, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THE SECOND ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY FOR A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS SECOND ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-20-12 TO BEGIN THE SECOND ROAD ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS SECOND ROAD EXTENDS EAST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE TO THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13 AT A TURN TO THE NORTH

- 5) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 28, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 28 DATED APRIL 21, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/2/4 CORNERS AND THE 1/4/4 CORNER IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,330' SOUTH TO THE TEMPORARY 1/2/4 CORNER HE SET ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13
 - 2) 2,660' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL

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- 6) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 38 DATED NOVEMBER 30, 1882 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-13 FOR J. C. COOLEY, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 31-20-13 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY. THERE IS NO WIDTH RECORDED ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 3-1/2 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18-20-13 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 7) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 199 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "B" ON PAGES 382 TO 384 PETITIONED BY J. C. COOLEY AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-13 [PACKET 477 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON NOVEMBER 30, 1882, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JANUARY 6, 1883 AS NOTED BY HUGH F. HOLMES, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOAR OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JANUARY 22, 1883 BY WILLIAM F. EWING, COUNTY CLERK, APPARENTLY **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-13 TO COMMENCE THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 3-1/2 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18-20-13 AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY
