

WEST 1/16 CORNER SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 19, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 19 DATED MARCH 1-5, 1870 TO SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,327-1/2' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13
 - 2) 1,327-1/2' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 28, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 28 DATED APRIL 21, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/2/4 CORNERS AND THE 1/4/4 CORNER IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,642' EAST TO THE TEMPORARY 1/2/4 CORNER HE SET ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13

- 3) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 186 & 187 [PACKET 21 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE] PETITIONED BY B. F. W. PERRY AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 20-13 AND 21-13 THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 10, 1871 AND WAS ORDERED ESTABLISHED AND RECORDED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON NOVEMBER 10, 1871 AS NOTED BY DAVID S. GILMORE, COUNTY CLERK, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING A TURN ON THIS ROAD SURVEY AT OR NEAR THE WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 80 RODS TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST FOR 13 RODS TO A TURN TO THE SOUTH

- 4) J. H. HIBBEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1875 TO 1882, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON THE LEFT PAGE 155 DATED MAY 6, 1878, APPARENTLY **FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 32
 - 2) 214-1/2' EAST TO AN ANGLE POINT IN THE ROAD SURVEY
