

WEST 1/16 CORNER SOUTHWEST 1/4 SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 28, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 28 DATED APRIL 21, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/2/4 CORNERS AND THE 1/4/4 CORNER IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13, SAID THAT **HE SET A TEMPORARY 1/2/4 CORNER** ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13 AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,330' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13
- 2) 1,330' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 32-20-13 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
