 - 2) 176.0' SSW TO A PK NAIL & WASHER IN THE TOP OF THE END GUARDRAIL POST
 - 3) 237.8' SOUTH TO THE NORTH EDGE OF WEARING SURFACE OF F.A.S. BRIDGE 40
 - 4) 1' NORTH TO THE TRAVELED WAY OF ASPHALT ROAD 80 TO THE WEST
 - 5) 1' WEST TO THE TRAVELED WAY OF ASPHALT ROAD "Y5" NORTH-SOUTH

- 1) 1.0' WEST TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF ASPHALT ROAD "Y5"
NORTH-SOUTH
- 2) 176.2' SSE TO A PK NAIL & WASHER IN THE TOP OF THE END GUARDRAIL POST
- 3) 176.0' SSW TO A PK NAIL & WASHER IN THE TOP OF THE END GUARDRAIL POST
- 4) 237.8' SOUTH TO THE NORTH EDGE OF THE BRIDGE DECK

- 3) 3,989.72' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR IN A MONUMENT WELL HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-20-13 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
