

**WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 01, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 250 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 19" X 10" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 1 & 2-21-10 ON JUNE 3, 1857.  
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 42.41 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 26" X 15" X 4" THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 1 & 2-21-10 ON THE 4<sup>TH</sup> STANDARD PARALLEL
  - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 24" X 9" X 6" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 1, 2, 11 & 12-21-10
  
- 2) THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR TOWNSHIP 21-10 SHOWS A **STONE** AT THE "E1/4 CORNER SECTION 2-21-10".
  - 1) 45' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR IN A FENCE ROW
  
- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JUNE 20, 1985, FOR JOB NUMBER 85074, SURVEY F02001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 21-10 TO SURVEY THE SOUTH HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 2 20-10 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 417 ON PAGE 299 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JUNE 27, 1985, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A 3" X 13" LIMESTONE AT 18" DEEP** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2-21-10 AS REFERENCED BY COUNTY TIES. **HE SET A 5/8" REBAR ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STONE AND A 1/2" REBAR ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE STONE AND BENT OVER THE TOP OF THE STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2-21-10.
  - 1) 45.2' EAST TO A 1/2" SQUARE IRON PIN
  - 2) 35.6' WEST TO A FENCE LINE NORTH-SOUTH
  - 3) 36.2' EAST TO A FENCE LINE NORTH-SOUTHHIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 2,660.40' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 2-21-10
  - 2) 5,301.38' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2-21-10
  - 3) 2,645.10' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2-21-10
  - 4) 7,935.30' SOUTH TO THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 11-21-10
