BROSEMER, L.S. 752, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED JUNE 20, 1985, FOR JOB NUMBER 85074, SURVEY F02001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 21-10 TO SURVEY THE SOUTH HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 2 20-10 AND RECORDED IN VOLUME 417 ON PAGE 299 IN THE REGISTER OF DEEDS OFFICE ON JUNE 27, 1985, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 2-21-10. HE SAID THAT THIS CORNER WAS SET BY HIS INTERPRETATION OF K.S.A. 19-1411, I.E. 40 CHAINS NORTH OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND PARALLEL WITH THE EAST LINE, AS DETERMINED BY THE SOUTHEAST CORNER AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 2-21-10. THIS POSITION FELL 5.9' SOUTH OF THE EAST-WEST FENCE AND 25.5' WEST OF THE NORTH-SOUTH FENCE. HE SAID THAT THESE FENCES ARE VERY OLD.

- 3) 1,320.00' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE S1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 2-21-10
- 4) 2,640.00' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE S1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 2-21-10
