

NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 05, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 272 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT THEY INTERSECTED THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL SOUTH AT 8.15 CHAINS WEST OF THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 31 & 32-21-10 AND 31.88 CHAINS EAST OF THE 1/4 CORNER. **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 15" X 3"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 5 & 6-21-10 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL ON JUNE 10, 1857.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 42.48 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 22" X 13" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 5 & 6-21-10
 - 2) 82.48 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 17" X 11" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 5, 6, 7 & 8-21-10

- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 87, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 87 FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIPS 20-10 AND 20-11 FOR J. C. DARR, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, DATED FEBRUARY 25, 1885, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-10 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL. THIS PORTION OF ROAD WAS **REJECTED** BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

- 3) ARTHUR MILLIKEN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 290 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 110 TO 112 PETITIONED BY JOHN C. DARR AND OTHERS FOR 2 ROADS IN TOWNSHIP 20-11 [PACKET 527 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON FEBRUARY 26, 1885, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 50 FOOT WIDE ROAD FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 16-20-10 TO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 30-20-10 – THE REST OF THE ROAD ON THE PETITION WAS **REJECTED** BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON JANUARY 9, 1885 AS NOTED BY JOHN L. BUTLER, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON MAY 16, 1885 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-10. THIS PORTION OF ROAD WAS **REJECTED** BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

 - 1) 2.15 CHAINS EAST ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31-20-10

- 4) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 301 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 154 TO 156 PETITIONED BY G. P. JONES AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 21-10 THAT HE SURVEYED ON JUNE 15, 1885, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD ON JULY 11, 1885 AS NOTED BY JOHN L. BUTLER, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JANUARY 22, 1886 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-10 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL AT THE TERMINUS OF THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 1 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-10; THEN WEST FOR 1/2 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-21-12; THEN SOUTH ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE FOR 4 MILES TO THE

STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-21-10 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 5) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 111, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 111 FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 21-10 FOR G. I. JONES, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, DATED JUNE 15, 1885, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-10 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL TO END THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 1 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6-21-10; THEN WEST FOR 1/2 MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-21-12; THEN SOUTH ON THE 1/4 SECTION LINE FOR 4 MILES TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30-21-10 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 6) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 120
ON OCTOBER 27, 1959, A PETITION SIGNED BY C. G. KARR AND OTHERS FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 16-11 WAS PRESENTED TO W. A. STOLFUS, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND W. D. KRETSINGER, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON OCTOBER 22, 1959 AND THE FINAL ORDER WAS NOT DATED BUT SIGNED BY ALL THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS **VACATING** THE FOLLOWING ROAD:
- 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-10, THENCE WEST TWO (2) MILES TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 5-21-10 AND THERE ENDING.
 - 2) NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT IN THE JUDGMENT OF SAID BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS THE ROAD HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED IS NOT A PUBLIC UTILITY BY REASON OF NEGLECT, NONUSE AND INCONVENIENCE
 - 3) BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT THE ABOVE DESCRIBED ROAD IS HEREBY **VACATED.**
