- 1) ON PAGE 270 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 24" X 12" X 4"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 7 & 8-21-10.

- 2) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 55, A JOINT **PERMANENT SURVEY** WITH THE CHASE COUNTY SURVEYOR RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 236 DATED SEPTEMBER 2 & 3, 1902 ORDERED BY D. S. RICHARDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-21-10 AND RUN SUCH LINES AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROPERLY COMPLETE THE WORK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE GOVERNMENT STONE** AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7-21-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED THAT ALL OF THE STONES THAT HE FOUND ON THIS SURVEY HAD THE GOVERNMENT MARKS ON THEM. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK NUMBER 3 ON PAGE 94, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS IN PACKET "M 67" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 3 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
