

**WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 259 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 14" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 9 & 10-21-10.
  
- 2) COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 122  
ON JANUARY 19, 1960, A PETITION SIGNED BY ALEX MURPHY AND OTHERS FOR THE **VACATION** OF TWO ROADS IN TOWNSHIP 21-10 WAS PRESENTED TO W. A. STOLFUS, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND W. D. KRETSINGER, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON FEBRUARY 16, 1960 AND THE FINAL ORDER WAS NOT DATED BUT THE VIEWERS REPORT WAS SIGNED BY ALL THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO **VACATE** THE FOLLOWING TWO ROADS:
  - 1) ROAD NUMBER 1: BEGINNING AT THE NORTH ONE QUARTER (N1/4) CORNER OF SECTION 10-21-10, THENCE RUNNING WEST ONE AND ONE-HALF (1-1/2) MILES TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 9-21-10 AND THERE ENDING.
  - 2) ROAD NUMBER 2: BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9-21-10, THENCE RUNNING SOUTH ONE-HALF (1/2) MILE TO THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SAID SECTION, AND ENDING THERE.
