- 1) ON PAGE 247 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 28" X 16" X 4"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 25 & 26-21-10.
- 2) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, IN SURVEY NUMBER 170, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 134 DATED JULY 16-20, 1888 AT THE REQUEST OF L. NEWMAN TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 AND THE LINE BETWEEN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-21-10, APPARENTLY DID **NOT** FIND THE STONE AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25-21-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
