

SOUTHWEST CORNER SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 109 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 30" X 6" X 5"** MARKED AND MOUNDED AS PER INSTRUCTIONS AT THE CORNER TO TOWNSHIPS 21 & 22 OF RANGES 9 & 10 EAST ON THE COUNTY LINE ON MARCH 12, 1857.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 24" X 8" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-21-10
 - 2) 80.00 CHAINS NORTH ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY AND THE COUNTY LINE TO THE 20" X 7" X 4" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 30 & 31-21-10
 - 3) 36.13 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 18" X 4" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 31-21-10
 - 4) 76.13 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 24" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 31 & 32-21-10
- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 19 IN SURVEY F31001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 21-10 DATED JULY 8TH, 1959, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING A "**MONUMENT**" AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31-21-10 ON THE RANGE LINE AND THE LYON, CHASE AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE. **NOTE: VERIFY AND CHECK FOR THE STONE OF RECORD AS THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE KRETSINGER REFERENCE TIE BOOK FOR THIS TOWNSHIP – WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
