- 1) ON PAGE 255 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 12" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 33 & 34-21-10.
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JUNE 6, 1991, FOR JOB NUMBER 91080, SURVEY F27001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-10 FOR A TRACT OF 0.731 ACRES FOR ADDITIONAL RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE LYON COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE DEPARTMENT DUE TO THE MOVEMENT OF THE VERDIGRIS RIVER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 3" X 12" GLO LIMESTONE STANDING MARKED WITH "1/4" ON THE EAST FACE AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34-21-10. HE SET REBARS ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDES OF THE STONE.** HE NOTED IN HIS *SURVEY NOTES* THAT THIS STONE WAS NOT TIED INTO HIS TRAVERSE.
