

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 45, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 45 DATED JUNE 24, 1884 AT THE REQUEST OF E. W. PILE TO ESTABLISH THE EAST LINE OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-21-10, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-21-10 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-21-10 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/4 OF 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-21-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
 - 1) A 7" DIAMETER WALNUT BEARS S. 40°17" E. AT 18 FEET DISTANCE
 - 2) A 9" DIAMETER WALNUT BEARS N. 40°17" W. AT 23 FEET DISTANCE
