

**SOUTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST**

- 1) ON PAGE 110 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 12" X 12" X 4"** IN A SMALL GROVE OF BUR OAK FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-21-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE COUNTY LINE ON MARCH 13, 1857, FROM WHICH:
  - 1) A BUR OAK 10" IN DIAMETER BEARS N. 32° E. AT 31 LINKS DISTANCE
  - 2) A BUR OAK 6" IN DIAMETER BEARS S. 75° W. AT 78 LINKS DISTANCE

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

  - 1) 40.00 CHAINS WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 26" X 12" X 3" SANDSTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 34 & 35-21-10
  - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 18" X 10" X 4" SANDSTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 35 & 36-21-10
  
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 45, A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 45 DATED JUNE 24, 1884 AT THE REQUEST OF E. W. PILE TO ESTABLISH THE EAST LINE OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-21-10, SHOWS ON HIS DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-21-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

  - 1) 1,323' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-21-10
  - 2) 2,646' WEST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 35-21-10
  
- 3) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, IN SURVEY NUMBER 170, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 134 DATED JULY 16-20, 1888 AT THE REQUEST OF L. NEWMAN TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 AND THE LINE BETWEEN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-21-10, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE IN THE GROUND AND IN GOOD CONDITION** AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-21-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE USED THIS STONE TO SET A 24" X 6" X 4" LIMESTONE MARKED WITH A "+" NEAR THE BOTTOM ON THE SOUTH SIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 35-21-10.

SOUTH QUARTER CORNER 35-21-10
