- 1) J. HARRISON PARKMAN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1907 TO 1915, BY J. MAX YINGLING, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 77 AND DATED 1910, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 35-21-10. HE SAID THAT THE STONE WAS 2.48' SOUTH OF HIS PRORATED POSITION, BUT HE DEEMED THAT SINCE THE STONE WAS IN ITS ORIGINAL POSITION IT WAS THE **LEGAL CORNER** ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
