

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST

- 1) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A PLAT SHOWING THE RESULTS OF A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO LOCATE THE LINE BETWEEN THE SOUTHWEST AND SOUTHEAST QUARTERS OF SECTION 36-21-10 DATED NOVEMBER 29, 1966 AND RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 50, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE SET A 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF A CORNER FENCE POST BASE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-10 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/16TH CORNER
- 2) 2,620' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" DIAMETER IRON PIN HE SET AT 20' NORTH OF THE STONE THAT HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-10
- 3) 2,640' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-10 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE
