

NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 02, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 13, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 193 DATED OCTOBER 4, 1900, FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 21-11 FOR CLEMMENS NUESSEN, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF SECTION 2-21-11 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. THE ROAD IS 50 FEET WIDE, ALL IN THE EAST 1/2 OF THE WEST 1/2 OF SECTION 2-21-11. HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 40.06 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 2-21-11
 - 2) 80.06 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH END OF THE LINE BETWEEN THE EAST 1/2 AND THE WEST 1/2 OF THE WEST 1/2 OF SECTION 2-21-11 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY

- 2) FINNEY & TURNIPSEED PLANS FOR BRIDGE NUMBER 945.2-540.2 SAID THERE WAS A **5/8" REBAR** AT P.O.T. STATION 40 + 00. **VERIFY BEFORE USING AS THIS MARYH HAVE BEEN "HEELED IN" FOR THE BRIDGE SURVEY!! WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR**
 - 1) 40.93' SW TO A SPIKE IN A POWER POLE
 - 2) 38.80' SE TO A SPIKE IN THE TOP OF A FENCE POST
 - 3) 53.05' NW TO A SPIKE IN A K-57/99 SIGN

- 3) LLOYD J. DOBLER, L.S. 541, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MARCH 17, 2005, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A 1/2" IRON BAR** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-21-11 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL. HE DID NOT HAVE A JOB NUMBER ON THE REPORT, OR STATE HIS METHOD OF RECOVERY OR ESTABLISHMENT ON THIS REPORT.
 - 1) 40.6' SW TO A RAILROAD SPIKE IN AN ELECTRIC POLE
 - 2) 47.1' WSW TO A FIBER OPTIC CABLE POST
 - 3) 38.8' SE TO THE CENTER TOP OF A TELEPHONE PEDESTAL
 - 4) ON THE CENTERLINE OF THE COUNTY ROAD RUNNING WEST

- 4) FRED I. GIBBS, L.S. 387, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MAY 12, 2008 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 08-035E, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A PK NAIL FLUSH WITH THE SURFACE** AT THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-21-11 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL.
 - 1) 40.6' SW TO A FOUND RAILROAD SPIKE IN A POWER POLE
 - 2) 47.1' WSW TO A FIBER OPTIC CABLE POST
 - 3) 38.8' SE TO THE TOP CENTER OF A TELEPHONE PEDESTAL
 - 4) 52.5' NE TO THE TOP CENTER OF A TELEPHONE PEDESTAL
 - 5) IN THE CENTERLINE OF THE ASPHALT ROAD EAST-WEST
