

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 43, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 42 DATED JUNE 13, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER OF SECTION 4-21-11 AND TO DIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SAID SECTION 4 BY A LINE RUNNING EAST & WEST, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-11 ON LINE AND AT THE "PROPER CORRECTIONS" BETWEEN THE STONES THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,320' NORTH TO THE TEMPORARY WEST 1/2/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 4-21-11
- 2) 3,077' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 4-21-11 ON THE 4TH STANDARD PARALLEL
- 3) 2,640-1/2' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-11
- 4) 2,640-1/2' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-21-11
