

CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY F10007 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 20-11 FOR FOUR TRACTS COMPRISING THE OLPE CITY LAKE, LOCATED IN PARTS OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER, THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER AND THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 3, AND PART OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 21, RANGE 11, SAID IN HIS *REPORT OF SURVEY* THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 10-21-11 TO BE AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS SURVEY. HE HAD FOUND A LARGE ROCK BY A CORNER FENCE POST, BUT THE ROCK AND FENCES ARE **NOT IN A REASONABLE POSITION** AND WAS NOT USED TO DETERMINE THE POSITION FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE SECTION.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,319.65' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-21-11
- 2) 2,639.30' WEST TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-21-11
- 3) 1,319.93' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10-21-11
- 4) 2,639.86' NORTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 3-21-11
- 5) 5,273.67' NORTH TO THE PIPE AND REBAR HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-21-11
