

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 409 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 18" X 14" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 11 & 12-21-11.

- 2) W. G. RUGGLES, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1915 TO 1928, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 186 DATED OCTOBER 20-22, 1926 ORDERED BY NELL MARTINDALE, JESSIE MARTINDALE STUGARD, AND HEATH MARTIN TO SURVEY THE JENNIE MARTINDALE ESTATE IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-2-11, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL LOCATION** FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-21-11, BUT THE POSITION WAS **NOT** MONUMENTED ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THE SURVEY NOTES WERE NOT COMPLETED ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,318.5' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 27-21-11
 - 2) 2,637.0' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27-21-11
 - 3) 2,637.1' NORTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27-21-11
 - 4) 5,277.1' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27-21-11
