H. DUNAGAN, AND F. E. SMITH, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-21-11 ON TRUE LINE AND AT ONE HALF THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17-21-11 AND THE STAKE THAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 17-21-11 ON THIS **CONSENT SURVEY**. **HIS DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**

  - 2) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 17-21-11
