

NORTH 1/4 CORNER SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 431 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 20" X 11" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 18 & 19-21-11.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 35.22 CHAINS WEST TO THE 22" X 15" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 18 & 19-21-11 ON THE WEST TOWNSHIP BOUNDARY
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE 21" X 12" X 4" SANDSTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 17, 18, 19 & 20-21-11

 - 1) BEGINNING ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST (1/4) QUARTER OF SECTION 19-21-11, THENCE 1/2 MILE EAST AND THERE ENDING.

ON APRIL 21, 1965 A PETITION SIGNED BY D. FOX AND OTHERS FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 21-11 WAS PRESENTED TO HOWARD E. ENSMINGER, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND W. D. KRETSINGER, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON MAY 14, 1965 AND THEY RECOMMENDED THAT THE FOLLOWING ROAD BE **VACATED:**
 - 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 19-21-11 AND TERMINATING AT 1,320 FEET EAST ON THE SECTION LINE.
