- 1) ON PAGE 106 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 16" X 10" X 5"** FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 34 & 35-21-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE COUNTY LINE ON NOVEMBER 26, 1856.

THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 40.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 22" X 12" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON THE EAST SIDE OF A RIDGE THAT COURSES NORTH AND SOUTH FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 35-21-11
- 2) 80.00 CHAINS EAST ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND COUNTY LINE TO THE 22" X 9" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET ON THE EAST SIDE BUT NEAR THE TOP OF A RIDGE THAT COURSES NORTHEAST AND SOUTHWEST FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 35 & 36-21-11
