- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 170, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 170 DATED JUNE 2 & 3, 1887 ORDERED BY C. H. HOLTON TO LOCATE THE CENTER OF SECTION 36-21-11, SAID THAT **HE SET AN 18" X 6" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
- 1) 1,317' SOUTH TO THE 2'-11" X 8" X 3" LIMESTONE THAT WAS SHARP ON TOP HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 36
 - 2) 2,634' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE
