HOLTON TO LOCATE THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
