- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 170, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 170 DATED JUNE 2 & 3, 1887 ORDERED BY C. H. HOLTON TO LOCATE THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A 2'11" X 8" X 3" LIMESTONE WITH A SHARP TOP** FOR THE PERMANENT WEST 1/8TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 36-21-11 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11 AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,317' NORTH TO THE 18" X 6" X 2-1/2" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11
- 2) 1,317' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 36-21-11 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND THE LYON AND GREENWOOD COUNTY LINE
